

WHY DO MILL?

Learning to communicate in another language is a vital part of cross-cultural ministry. Yet many people go to the field without adequate preparation for learning a new language.

Being equipped with tools to help in the task of language learning can reduce some of the stress of living and working in a cross-cultural environment.

MILL is a 7 day pre-departure program designed to help you develop the skills, techniques, methods and attitudes necessary to learn another language.

The course explores issues in language acquisition, phonetics and basic linguistic principles. The focus is practical, giving experience working with native speakers, and individual consultations relating to specific languages and ministry contexts.

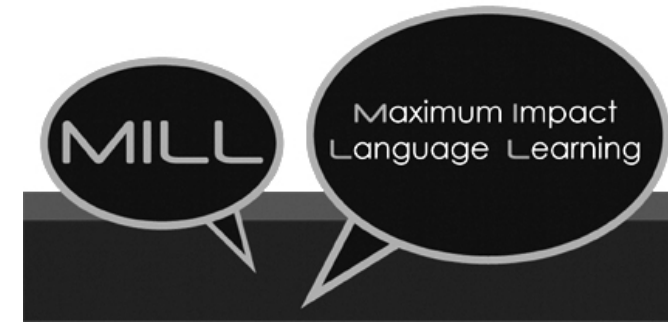

2010 Course Details

Tuesday 15 to Wednesday 23 June.
Classes run Mon - Fri 9am - 4pm (*no weekend or evening sessions*).
(Participants may arrive at the venue any time from 3pm Monday 14 June)

Course Fees: \$350 per person

This includes tuition, materials, and morning and afternoon tea.

Accommodation: \$350 per person

Full board includes accommodation and all meals from Monday evening 14th June to lunch on Tuesday 23rd June, except for the weekend.

Participants not requiring on-site accommodation are welcome to stay for lunch or dinner (\$10 per person) (24 hours notice required).

Families: Reduced rates for meals and accommodation are available for accompanying children. **Child care** can be provided at a cost of \$20-25 per child per day (discounted for families with more than one child). Children over the age of 12 are welcome to participate in certain sections of the course.
